Forchir 2010 Pinot Grigio 'Lamis' (Italy)

Light straw-yellow colour with a light, pleasant peach pit aroma. Dry and lean, full-bodied with a distinct almond aftertaste.

Cave Spring Riesling Estate 2009 (Ontario)

Flavours of grapefruit and peach mingle with white honey to produce a dry, medium-bodied wine with great length.

Megalomaniac "Home Grown" Riesling

Wonderful aromas of apple, pear, and citrus combine to create a very appealing food friendly wine.

Villa Maria Private Bin 2010 Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand)

Aromas of gooseberry, passion fruit and freshly cut grass, crisply dry with a long finish.

The Foreign Affair Winery Sauvignon Blanc

The drying process has concentrated the varietal character here, with wonderful lemon, lime and herbs on the nose.

Southbrook Triomphe Chardonnay 2007 (Ontario)

Canada's first certified bio-dynamic wine: fresh apple and vanilla flavours, very Burgundian in style.

Ravine Vineyard "Sand & Gravel York Road"

Dry and very food friendly the wine shows off the aromatics of Gewurztraminer, the acidity of Sauvignon Blanc, and the weight/structure of Chardonnay.

13th Street Pinot Gris

Rich full and gently aromatic with pear, honey, yellow plum compote and butter notes.

Red Wines by the Glass

Jackson Triggs 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon / Cabernet Franc

Intensely aromatic, exhibiting a core of ripe plum, anise, blackcurrant and bell pepper. Bold fruit flavours supported by firm leather tannins lead to a rich, extended finish.

Vina La Rosa La Palma Merlot 2010 (Chile)

A fruit-driven, mouth-filling supple wine with blueberry and black fruit flavours.

Megalomaniac "Home Grown Red"

Wonderful berry notes on the nose, an inviting black-cherry red colour, and abundant dark fruit flavours.

Maculan Cabernet Sauvignon di Breganze 2009 (Veneto)

Brilliant ruby red with an intense bouquet of licorice and red berry fruit; full on the palate. Firmly structured with a tannic lift on the finish.

McManis Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 (California)

The nose offers aromas of ripe blackberries, fresh boysenberries and plums melded with smoky oak. A creamy palate with juicy fruit.

Stoney Ridge "Warren Classic" Pinot Noir 2010

A dark, black-fruit driven Pinot with excellent Pinot flavours of cinnamon, beetroot, and cherry-raspberry fruit.

Valdibella "Kerasos" Nero d'Avola 2009 (Sicily)

Purple plum, liquorice and spice make up the flavours of this dry, juicy, mouth-filling wine.

The Foreign Affair Winery "The Conspiracy"

Dark purple and black cherry in colour, this wine shows great intensity on the nose, with deep black and red fruit, suggesting plum, cassis, black cherry.

Amayna 2008, Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)

This wine emits a stylish perfume of fresh herbs, new cut grass, citrus and melon.

De Martino Legado Reserve Chardonnay 2009 (Chile)

Rich flavours of honey dew melon with floral and mineral notes.

Tinpot Hut Sauvignon Blanc 2010 (New Zealand)

Big, grassy nose. Lovely depth, intensity and minerality. Lively, refreshing, crisp passion fruit flavours with a lining finish.

L'Ecole No.41 2009, "Walla Voila" Chenin Blanc (Washington)

Fresh, tart and delightfully fruity, shows Asian pear, perfume honeysuckle and orange blossom aromas with flavours of apple, apricot and grapefruit.

Domaine Jean Marc Brocard Chablis

Domaine St. Clair 2008 (Burgundy)

Flavours of grapefruit and white honey mingle with floral and mineral notes carried on lively acidity. A versatile food wine.

Feudi Di San Gregorio 2009 Fiano di Avellino (Campania)

Pale gold with a greenish tint; a distinctive flavour of sweet herbs, and citrus fruit.

Jermann Chardonnay 2010 (Friuli)

Italian Chardonnay at its best: Rich, ripe sweet apple and citrus fruit, beautifully balanced and mouth-filling.

Pascal Jolivet Sancerre Chateau du Nozay 2009 (Loire)

A rich, expressive Sauvignon, full on the palate with citrus and green fig flavours.

Schug Carneros Estate Chardonnay 'Sonoma' 2008 (California)

A ripe, spicy tropical bouquet with flavors of citrus, pear and apple-butter. Well-balanced acidity gives it a crisp, clean finish.

Planeta Chardonnay 2007 (Sicily)

A full bore Chardonnay with a rich spicy apple flavour with floral and pie crust notes.

Alpha Zeta 'R' Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso 2008 (Veneto)

A nose of sour cherries and smoky oak. Full and rich on the palate with spicy cherry flavours balanced by smooth, rounded tannins.

Francis Ford Coppola Zinfandel 'Red Label' 2009 (California)

Sweet, spicy, fruity nose with flavours of strawberry and plum jam; rich and round on the palate.

Malivoire 2009 Courtney Gamay (Ontario)

Ontario's answer to Beaujolais. Spice plum and cherry flavours backed with notes of coffee and cinnamon spice.

Au Bon Climat Santa Barbara County Pinot Noir Santa Barbara 2008 (California)

Richly extracted flavours of black raspberry and spicy oak with lively acidity.

Domaine de Nalys Châteauneuf-du-Pape Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2008 (Rhône)

A potpourri of black fruits with notes of leather and dried herbs; medium-bodied with great structure.

Vineland Estates Winery Cabernet Franc Reserve 2007 (Ontario)

The Red Wine of the Year at the Ontario Wine Awards 2010.

Meandro 2008, Vino Tinto 2008 (Duro)

This concentrated red shows restrained power to its flavors of roasted red plum, dark cherry and blackberry. Broad and rich on the finish, with plenty of savoury spice and chocolate notes.

Marchese Antinori Chianti 2006 (Tuscany) Classico DOCG Riserva

Intense aromas of red fruit stand out. On the palate the wine is well-balanced, with warm notes of vanilla and chocolate.

Castello di Ama Chianti Classic 2007 (Tuscany)

A very elegant Chianti with a silky mouth feel and rich flavours of mulberry and cherries.

Vosne-Romanee Village 2007 (Bourgogne)

Supple, with licorice, spice, black cherry and raspberry notes, this red turns chewy and slightly tough on the finish. There's a smokey, mineral conclusion.

Ceretto "Fonchera" Barolo 2005 (Alba)

Very ripe on the nose with oak tones accenting the sweet, pruny and strawberry jam fruits. It's a bit soft in the mouth though well balanced with lots of mineral notes buttressing the light strawberry fruits.

Tignanello 2007 (Tuscany)

This Super Tuscan offers vibrant red fruit flavours layered with chocolate and coffee nuances. A very stylish and elegant wine.
